
## Biblical Chronology From Solomon to Abraham


1 Kings 11:43 Death of Solomon	931 BC

Kings 6:1  Exodus from Egypt was years before temple construction began	
Exodus 12:40 Length of the Egyptian sojourn	
<b>Gen 47:9</b> Jacob's age at start of sojourn	= birth date




## Other Views

It is estimated that Abraham's narrative, when he left Ur with his extended family, picks up when he was about 40 years old.

He entered Canaan at the age of 75 (Gen 12:4), or 2090 BC. This would place Abraham in Canaan toward the end of the Early Bronze Age, and in Egypt during the 1<sup>st</sup> Intermediate Period.

However, not all biblical historians accept the biblical chronology as it is given in the Hebrew text.



Despite the text, specifically 1 Kings 6:1, many biblical scholars prefer a 13<sup>th</sup> century date for the Exodus. This lowers the preceding chronology by a similar amount, if the preceding periods are viewed as historical.

Others, like Beitzel, accept the reading of the Septuagint over the Hebrew text. Exodus 12:40 (LXX) "And the sojourning of the children of Israel, while they sojourned in the land of Egypt and the land of Canaan, was four hundred and thirty years."
