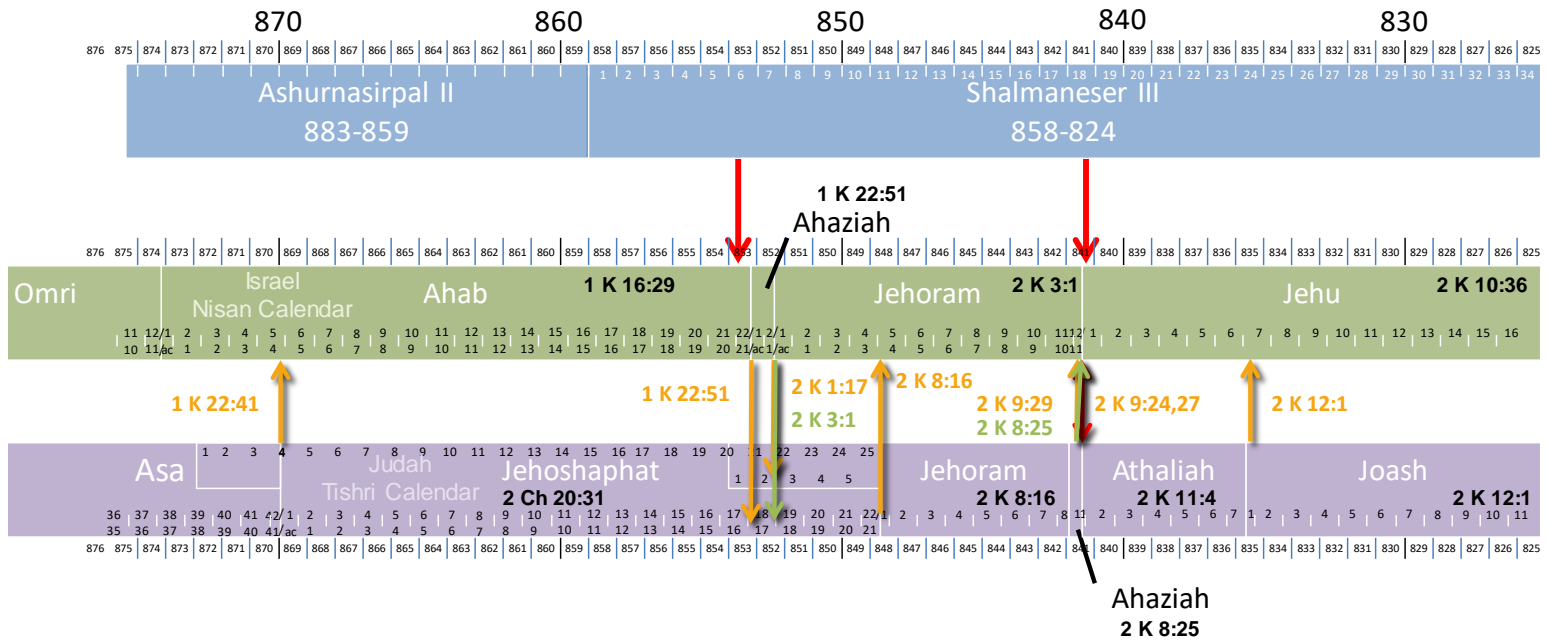
Edwin Thiele put together three critical factors that allowed him to solve the riddle of the reign length data of the kings:
