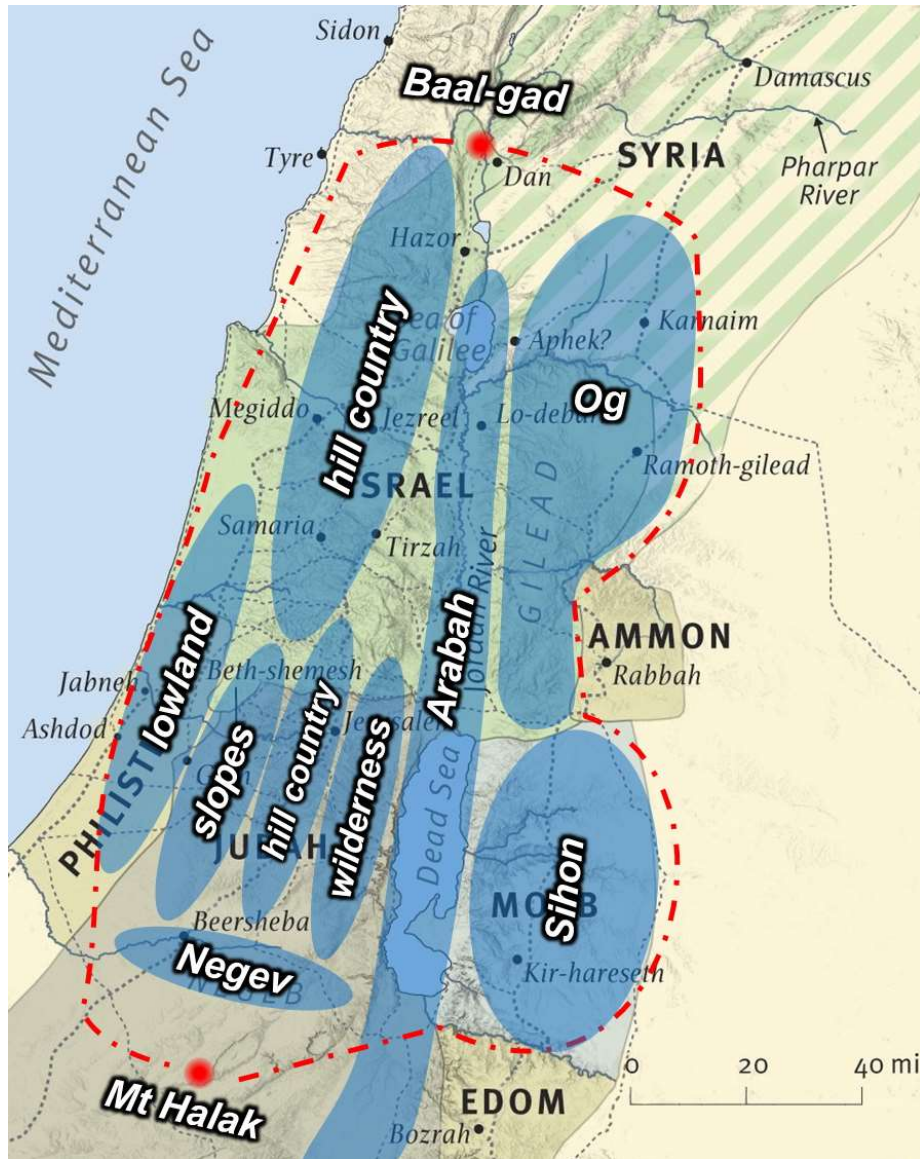


Joshua 12
