Acts 3:1-10 Healing the Lame Beggar

Peter and John heal a man who was lame from birth, at the gate called Beautiful.

The location of this gate is uncertain. Locations that have been suggested include the Shushan (Golden) gate, the entrance to the Court of the Women, the entrance to the Court of the Israelites, the gate above Robinson's Arch, and the Double (Hulda) Gate on the southern end of the Temple Mount.



What is the significance of this healing?

This is not the first time a disciple of Jesus healed someone – Luke 10:9-20.

This is the first specific healing by a disciple of Jesus, but many are to follow.

This miracle demonstrates that the hand of God is upon these men—they are filled with the Holy Spirit.

"The kingdom of God has come near you!" Luke 10:9.

This gift from God authenticates the message preached by Peter and John.
