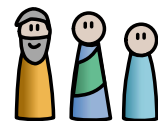

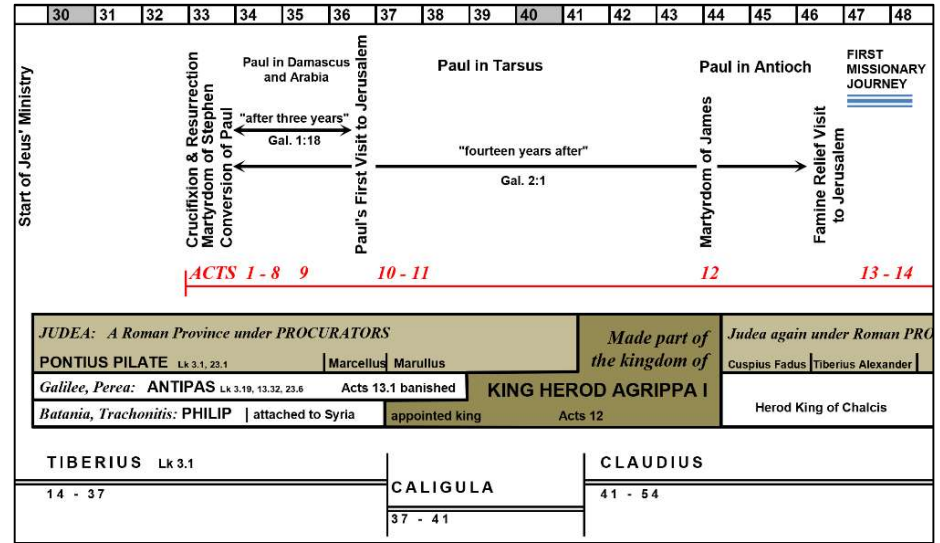

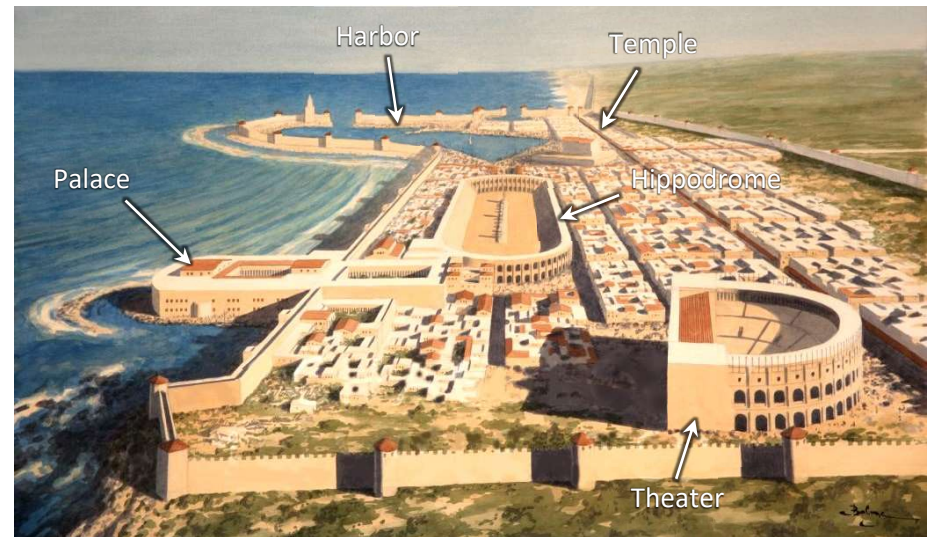


Food for Thought
