Paul's first missionary journey focused on the island of Cyprus and on southeastern Asia Minor. His three voyages totaled about 620 miles, or about 5-6 days at sea. The distance he walked was about 850 miles. This is about the same distance as walking from Omaha to Chicago and back, or Lincoln to Denver and back. If he averaged about 15 miles per day, this would have been about 2 months straight of walking.
