

Like Paul's first missionary journey, the second was also based out of Antioch on the Orontes. The beginning of Paul's second missionary journey was to revisit the churches planted in Lycaonia. The fact that Barnabas went to Cyprus implies that Paul did not, and the order of the cities he first visited indicates that he travelled overland, beginning with Cilicia {and perhaps his own hometown of Tarsus}.
